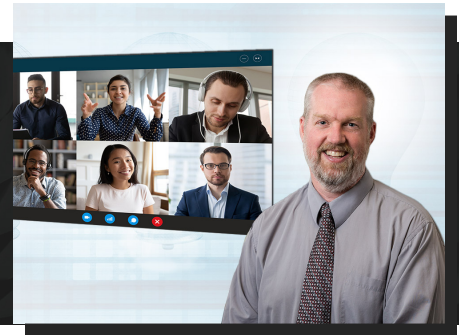


Stetson Moderates ABX LIVE Virtual Presentation
